I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Bob Hunt at 7:10 pm.

II. Reading of the Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were read. Fran Williams moved to approve the minutes as read; Gene Robinson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

III. Financial Report: Fran Williams, Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's report for the previous month.

a. Fran reported that the Summer Reading Program at the Library will be June 15th – August 5th. The library will be closed on August 15 for renovations for the ADA Compliance bathroom and widened doorways. It expected that this will take three to six weeks.

IV. Committee Reports:

A. ICL Santiago Fire Relief Effort: No report.

B. Fire Safe Council: Mary Schreiber reported that the second Canyon Cleansweep weekend is June 13 and 14. Trails4All will sponsor creek clearance in September. Several Fire Safe Council members attended the recent meeting at Pala Casino, near Escondido.

C. Canyon Watch: Gene Robinson reported that the antenna tower at the Franklin repeater site is up and running and at full extension. He is planning to activate Canyon Watch on July 4th and 5th. There has been a series of small fires

in or around Holy Jim Canyon in Trabuco, which have residents concerned. It is hoped that the Red Cross grant will be announced at the end of this month.

D. Community Directory: No report.

E. Brown Baggers Seniors Group: Judy Myer reported that the group continues to grow. The annual potluck will be held at MaryAnn Turner's home in Modjeska.

F. Forest Liaison Committee: Hank Rodgers reported that work continues on the building at the end of Silverado Canyon. The roof and fascia are not yet completed. The Santa Ana Mountains Historical Society will man the building, Saturdays and Sundays from 9am until 4pm (volunteers are needed and welcomed).

G. ICL Website: No report.
